There were no further nominations, and upon a motion by Mack Adams the slate was elected by acclamation.

The Treasurer's report submitted by Lindsay Baldner was presented by Ron Jursa and accepted.

The printed minutes of the business meeting of May 18, 1979, were accepted as written.

Bill Hilton reported on the work of the Information Services Committee. After discussion, this committee was continued for another year. He asked for additional persons to volunteer to serve on this committee.

Joe Boyd presented the 11th Annual Survey of the NASSGP. He reported that Illinois would provide continuity of services for the survey until June 30, 1980, but that a new chairman should be designated for this task before then.

Ron Jursa reported on services provided by ECS to the Association, noting that the meetings were now too large for one state to assume the burden of planning. Information and lobbying benefits were also discussed. The practice of joint meetings with NCHelp was also discussed at this time, and it was noted that the president-elect of NCHelp favors the practice of joint meetings.

The report of the Federal Policy Committee was given by Haskell Rhett and Ron Jursa. This committee of necessity has primarily included those who can commute often to Washington. Others are encouraged to participate. The need for this committee to be free to act when needed was stressed. Activities of the committee since the last business meeting included working on testimony with the American Council on Education, arranging for NASSGP representation at federal regional hearings, and meetings with personnel of the Bureau of Student Financial Aid. Appreciation was expressed for the time and effort devoted to this committee by Haskell Rhett.

The work of Gary Smith of Pennsylvania in putting together the Fall, 1979, program was gratefully acknowledged.
