CAUTION: DO NOT submit new names by responding to this listserv. Any further nominations should come directly to me as the Chair of the Nominations Committee so that I can confirm willingness to run.

Section 4. Officers shall be elected in the following manner:

- a. In the fall the Executive Committee shall appoint a Nominating Committee consisting of five voting members. This committee shall prepare a proposed slate of officers for the next fiscal year and will present that slate to the members in the spring. No member of the Nominating Committee shall be eligible to be named on the proposed slate; however, a member may be nominated by a Voting Member or included as a write-in candidate on a ballot.**
- b. Voting Members may nominate eligible candidates for any office so provided by the parliamentary authority of Article VIII.**
- c. If a spring meeting is not held, the Nominating Committee chairman shall determine the slate by means of a committee meeting, or by communicating with the committee members by phone or by mail and shall provide the names of the proposed candidates to the President no later than May 1 of the year following the fall annual meeting. Once the President has been notified the Nominating Committee chairman shall present the proposed slate to Voting Members so that additional candidates may be**

nominated within 5 days. The Nominating Committee chairman will validate the willingness to run with any candidates nominated from the Voting Members.

- d. The President shall direct the Secretary to prepare ballots which shall contain the names and a brief description of the experience and qualifications of each candidate nominated according to Sections 4 a and b of Article IV. The Secretary will also provide a space for write-in candidates for each office. The Secretary shall make these ballots available to each eligible Voting Member by June 1.**
- e. Voting members must return their ballots as directed by the Secretary.**
- f. The person receiving the largest number of votes, whether or not a majority of the votes is cast, shall be elected.**
- g. The Secretary shall promptly notify the President and the members of the results of the election. This must be done prior to the next fall meeting.**
- h. The elected officers shall begin their terms at the conclusion of the fall business meeting.**
