Theresa:

I suspect the remainder of \$37K it will be due to GBPI by June of this year and yes we got \$10,000 from Lumina for 5 years to be matched with \$10,000 from NASSGAP. That means that we'll be taking \$20K from Lumina and another \$20K from NASSGAP by June or so of this year (providing everything gets done and I have no reason to believe it won't). Part of what needs to be talked about at your meeting is not only where we are now and where will we be by conference time, but where do we want to go from here (beyond the \$40K). Mike and I have ideas and most of them center on making the survey data as assessable (slice and dice) on the web as possible. It sort of depends upon what we want to do with old survey data.
